World Focus Sunday: This will be on Sunday 9th September both morning and evening. Gani and Adile Smolica, along with Esat and Samire, will be with us in the morning, updating us on the work Kosovo. In the evening we will hear from other friends about their time in South-east Asia over the last couple of years. We love these people and it will be great to hear from them. Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child boxes: It's time to fill a shoe box to show God's love in a tangible way to needy children around the world this Christmas. The leaflets and shoe boxes have arrived and can be found in the foyer. Beth Arnold & Ros Jackson have created a fantastic display on the noticeboard next to the pigeon holes giving further information and ideas so please take a look at this. We shall be having a pick-up point, here at the church, at the beginning of November. Please note that the suggested donation has increased to £5 to cover the costs involved – please see the leaflets for further details.

Sharpening your interpersonal skills (SYIS): We advertised the possibility of hosting this training course at Woodlands, run by International Training Partners, back in the spring. We are now able to confirm that we have secured the services of 4 accredited trainers and so the course will run next year on 2 consecutive weekends, March 15-17 and March 22-24. This is such an important subject for us as Christians and we do hope that many in the church will avail themselves of this fantastic opportunity, despite the large commitment required. The Fridays may even be taken as 'continuous professional development' in some organisations rather than annual leave. We only have a maximum of 24 places available so please do let Colette Patterson know as soon as possible if you intend being a participant. All church members are eligible and Tim and Philippa Gunn have already 'bagged' the first two places! There will be a cost involved but we are hoping to keep this to a minimum with the church offering some subsidy. You may never get this chance again to develop an essential life skill!
