Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child boxes: It's time to fill a shoe box to show God's love in a tangible way to needy children around the world this Christmas. The leaflets and shoe boxes have arrived and can be found in the foyer. We shall be having a pick-up point, here at the church, at the beginning of November.

Book of the term: We are recommending 2 very short, readable books for the church to enjoy over the autumn months to coincide with our current emphasis on prayer. Abi Case and chicken pox: Abigail Case is one of our JAM children who is 7 years old and in JAM class 3. In 2010 Abi was diagnosed with Aplastic Anaemia and had a donor bone marrow transplant in March 2011. This treatment has been successful but for about 2 years following this treatment Abi was not able to mix with other children because of the health risks. Abi is now less at risk of developing serious infections if she is in contact with children with colds or "flu" however she is still at risk if she comes into direct contact with a child with chickenpox or measles. (A direct contact is classified as being in the same indoor environment as a child with confirmed chickenpox or measles for at least 20 minutes). This risk will be for life. We wanted to make you aware of Abi's situation and ask that if you have a child come out with chickenpox or measles after being at church you let Gideon or Becky Case know so Abi can be given the appropriate treatment. Thank you.

Gideons at Derby University Freshers' Fair: This Monday and Tuesday the Gideons will be at Derby University, God willing, offering New Testaments to students and others. Last year 1050 Testaments were accepted. Please pray that the Holy Spirit will be preparing people to accept copies of God's word and that in reading them they will come to know God in a very real way. This is an international outreach as many students have come to Derby from overseas.
